So this is an important time to be able to be very clear on what the Word of God says regarding these topics. Please pray for that day as many pastors throughout America and the world preach on this topic. Please plan to be here and bring others for this important Biblical stand.

Book of the Week: The Reformed Pastor, by Richard Baxter

Richard Baxter was vicar of Kidderminster from 1647 to 1661...His ministry transformed the people of Kidderminster from 'an ignorant, rude and revelling people' to a godly, worshipping community. These pages, first prepared for a Worcestershire association of ministers in 1656, deal with the means by which such changes are ever to be accomplished. In his fervent plea for the discharge of the spiritual obligations of the ministry, Baxter, in the words of his contemporary, Thomas Manton, 'came nearer the apostolic writings than any man in the age'....A century later Philip Doddridge wrote, 'The Reformed Pastor is a most extraordinary book...many good men are but shadows of what (by the blessing of God) they might be, if the maxims and measures laid down in that incomparable Treatise were strenuously pursued'.

A Stand on Biblical Sexual Morality

Dear Minister of the Gospel,

I write to you this Christmas season to call your attention to an urgent matter in which the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ is under attack.

On December 22, I received an email from Pastor James Coates of GraceLife Church of Edmonton in Alberta, Canada. You will remember that he was recently imprisoned for keeping his church open during COVID-19 lockdowns. James is a graduate of The Master's Seminary and co-author (with Dr. Nathan Busenitz) of an excellent new book—God and Government (to be released March 2022). James's recent email gave me insight into the Canadian government's decision to pass Bill C-4, which "directly comes against parents and counsellors who would seek to offer biblical counsel with respect to sexual immorality and gender." James indicates that it could be used to "criminalize evangelism." To clarify the bill, James forwarded this email from Pastor Andrew DeBartolo:



2022: Public Schools Continue to Shed Students as Homeschooling Surges

One of the defining educational issues of 2021 has been the decision by many parents to reevaluate their means of educating their children, and more are opting to remove them from government-run schools in favor of other alternatives, including homeschooling, which has shown a significant surge.

In its December report on data showing a migration of students from public schools, NPR describes the change as "troubling":

We compiled the latest headcount data directly from more than 600 districts in 23 states and Washington, D.C., including statewide data from Massachusetts, Georgia and Alabama. We found that very few districts, especially larger ones, have returned to pre-pandemic numbers. Most are now posting a second straight year of declines.

Among the school districts losing students is New York City, where enrollment dropped by about 38,000 students during the 2020-2021 academic year, with an additional loss of 13,000 in the current school year.






