### The Power of Fear, Weak Faith, and a Sovereign God

Fear is so powerful that it can completely debilitate a person. It operates in the mind and often focuses on real or imaginary threats by exaggerating the possibilities rather than considering a more balanced outcome or positive solution. Fear focuses on the negative rather than the positive and although it functions in the mind, it affects the body as a whole.

My small group is reading through Martyn Lloyd-Jones' book titled "Spiritual Depression" and he does a good job of diagnosing the root cause and pointing his readers to a proper solution. At one point, he observes, "That is always the trouble with weak faith, it comes back again to questions which it has already solved and answered. If you have ever believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, you must, in some shape or form, have met with and dealt with the difficulties or you would not have arrived at faith. Well, why go back? It is sheer folly."

When the disciples found themselves on the boat in the middle of a severe storm at sea—they were terrified. The waves were coming into the boat and they believed they had reached the end. They literally believed they were about to die. It was at that moment that they did the unthinkable, they woke Jesus who was sleeping and rebuked him for his lack of concern for their welfare.




